**Actions:** Astringent, anti-inflammatory, and decongestant to the membranes of the eyes, nose & sinuses, and the throat and upper respiratory tract.

**Uses:** Specific for symptomatic relief of **hay fever and other allergies** which manifest as **acute catarrhal inflammation of the ocular, nasal, upper respiratory and throat membranes**, with sneezing, profuse watery secretion or abundant flow of mucus.

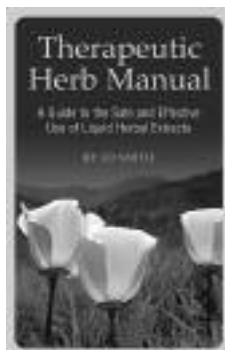
**Dose: Acute:** Three to five times per day take 30 to 40 drops in water.

**Chronic:** Two to three times per day take 30 to 40 drops in water.

**Adjunct Therapy:** IMMUNE DEFENSE TONIC may be helpful in certain persistent allergy conditions associated with a weakened immune system.
